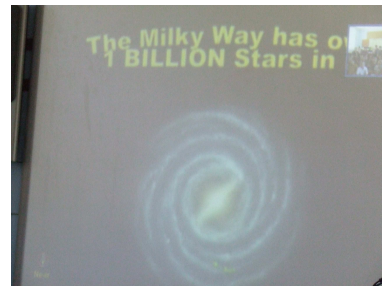
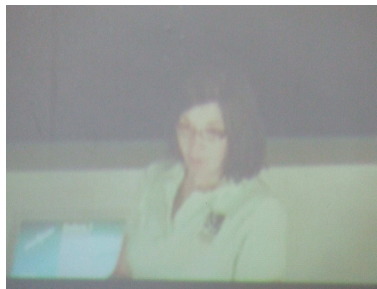
NASA Video Conference
