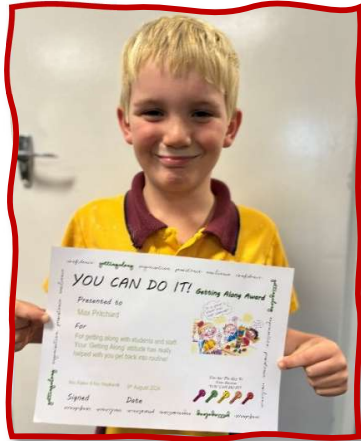


Yetman Public School
